According to Ms. Harof, the free jazz series has become a summer tradition for metro-Atlanta families, couples and singles seeking entertainment alternatives.

"Coming out to the Jazz Series, even if you're not a huge jazz fan or if you've never been exposed to jazz before, coming out to the gardens is just a wonderful way to spend the afternoon."

Summer Jazz Series performances will be held June 25, July 30, Aug. 27, Sept. 24 and Oct. 22 at Villa Christina restaurant. Doors open at 4 p.m. and all performances begin at 5:30 p.m. Food and beverages will be available for purchase during each concert.
